ESTIMATE how much vegetables and fruit **WEIGH** and check the weight at the supermarket or at home.

- HEIGHT CHART: Record your child's growth on a height chart and discuss how much they have grown
- TIME: Talk about events in terms of time
 - Clock time (refer to the clock)
 - Calendar time days, months, seasons
 - Length of time to complete an activity half an hour, 45 minutes
- BAKING with your children helps them to develop
 - Measurement skills
 - Understanding of Fractions
 - Co-ordination
 - Oral language
 - A love of cooking

• TAKE A TRIP

Estimate how long it will take to read a destination travelling at a set speed and time the trip.
e.g. to travel 60 kms at 100 kms per hour
